The data sharing sheet is no longer required as only George Romney staff will be looking after your child.

I have already communicated with the Y6 parents this week and when I have received all responses, I will finalise the plans for the next stages of their phased return to school. Thank you for your patience and understanding as we try to navigate these complex and anxious times.
